How to create a dedicate App password

What's a dedicated App password?

Within your [personal settings](#) you can generate a dedicated password for each App with which you want to access Soldupe Cloud Services. That means, you don't have to use your standard password in all the apps you are using to access Soldupe.

Why should I use a dedicated App password?

There are several good reasons:

- It adds an additional layer of security.
- If you change your password, you don't have to change it in all apps which access Soldupe.
- You can easily revoke dedicated app passwords in case you lose your device or it gets stolen.

Do not confuse this feature with Two-Factor Authentication, which is not supported by Soldupe.

Creating a dedicated App password

It's done in only three steps and it works like this:

1. Move over to the [Soldupe Web interface / personal settings](#)

App passwords

2. Give the App a name, so you can easily distinguish between several app passwords (and especially remember which password belongs to which app, in case you want to revoke it 😊)

3. You can now use that Username / Password combination with the app of your choice. Please be aware, that this password is only shown once!

Allow filesystem access

Revoking a generated password is easy: Just login to the [Soldupe Web interface](#) and click the Revoke button as seen in the picture above.
